Church Road is the only road gritted in the village.

PCSO Sore reported that between 15 November and 9 January there was one reported crime in the village, which was the vandalism of the advertising material at the new housing development on Church Road.

i.e. a lot of the comments stated that items needed cleaning, needed graffiti removed and small items such as missing bolt caps needed attention. It was agreed that the parish council would arrange a general spring clean of the equipment in a few months time, when hopefully the weather is dryer. The goal posts are lose and rusting. The clerk will contact the school to see if they are actually used at all and will also obtain costs for a new aluminium set. The clerk will also contact the company who installed the new play equipment to enquire about the length of warranty, given that some of the wood is reported as rotten. It was also agreed to obtain quotes for lifting the mats, levelling the surfaces and replacing, or using an alternative surface underneath the matting to try to prevent the same problem happening again. The clerk will also obtain quotes for an alternative surface in the shelter. **Action AR**.

- Play area zip wire status report The clerk will obtain a quote for the repair to the zip wire and also for having the tension tested and a general overhaul. Action AR.
- SAM2 Councillor Dalmazzo went to Westcotec to receive assistance with extracting the data and ensuring that the settings on the machine were correct. Positive feedback has been received from residents on Hethel Road confirming an improvement to speeding issues during the period when the machine was sited there. Councillor Dalmazzo confirmed that the machine can be sited at a spot and still collect the data but not display any information and felt this could be used on the B1113 to highlight the speeding issue to the police. After discussion, it was agreed to place the machine in one of the pre-approved spots in the village when it is next back in May, with a view to considering other options at a later date.
- Speeding stickers Following a query raised in the last meeting, the clerk ascertained that Ashwellthorpe Parish Council obtained the "speed aware" stickers for their wheelie bins from a company called Smartwheelie, at a cost of £390 for 1000 stickers. The clerk will ask some of her other parishes if they would be interested in sharing the cost. Action AR.
- Tree works rescheduled to February half term Tree works will now take place between 13 17 February.
- Any time limited village and highways issues Councillor Moon mentioned several overgrown hedges in the village, notably on Church Road and Wymondham Road. The Chairman will place an item in the Mardle reminding landowners and individual householders of their responsibility to ensure their hedging does not encroach onto the Highway. A member of the public present, Mr Minns, confirmed he will pay for the hedging next to the road at the play area to be cut, an offer which was gratefully received. Action MH and AR.

 possibility of laying bark on the surface. The clerk will ask the footpath warden for feedback
