A11 Spooner Row to Tuttles Interchange reconstruction scheme – Closure of northbound contraflow lane

I'm writing to let you know that, due to operational requirements, we'll no longer need to close the A11 northbound contraflow lane each evening between 12 September to 16 September 2022.

However, instead we will need to close the A11 between Attleborough and the Tuttles Interchange from Monday 5 September to Friday 9 September 2022 every evening between the hours of 8pm and 6am.

This will allow us to remove the old central reservation barrier from the carriageway. This will take place overnight so our team can work in the safest way possible, while allowing us to keep the A11 road between Spooner Row and Tuttles Interchange open during the day. The work is not expected to be noisy, and we'll do our best to complete it as quickly as possible, however all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.

The diversion will be clearly signposted, and a map can be found on the following page. Customers wanting to travel northbound on the A11 will be asked to travel along the A1066, before joining the A140 northbound, and then the A47 towards Thickthorn.
