

Upcoming work 4 October 2022

A11 Spooner Row to Tuttles Interchange reconstruction scheme – southbound and northbound closures, and temporary change of layout to B1135.

I'm writing to let you know that, as part of our ongoing reconstruction of the A11 carriageway between Spooner Row and the Tuttles Interchange, we'll need to close the A11 road, as well as a temporary change to the layout of the B1135 at the Tuttles Interchange, for safety reasons. The road closures will take place overnight when traffic is at its lowest, and this will allow us to keep the roads open during the day.

This work may be noisy at times, and we'd like to apologise in advance for any disturbance caused by our activity. We'll instruct our teams to do their best to keep any disruption to a minimum.

Southbound A11 road closures for vegetation clearance

We'll be closing the A11 southbound each night from 12 October to 14 October 2022 inclusive between the hours of 8pm and 6am, to allow our teams to safely clear some low-level scrub and vegetation.

During this time, traffic wishing to travel southbound on the A11 will be diverted along the A47 before joining the A140, and then the A1066 towards Thetford, before rejoining the A11. You can find a map of the diversion route at the end of this letter.

Northbound Tuttles Interchange entry slip closure

We'll be closing the A11 northbound Tuttles Interchange entry slip on the evening of 14 October 2022, between the hours of 8pm and 6am, to allow our teams to safely undertake some safety critical CCTV repairs.

During this time, traffic wishing to travel northbound on the A11 will be invited to travel along B1172 before joining the A47 at Thickthorn.

Temporary changes on B1135

We'll be closing the B1135 from the Tuttles Interchange southbound exit slip road to the roundabout with the B1172, on 17 October 2022 between the hours of 8pm and 6am. This is so we can temporarily alter the current layout of this road, allowing us to construct to the end of the exit slip road. The temporary layout will last for 6 weeks, and includes a shallow bend in the road, as well as a 40mph speed limit along the B1135.

When the B1135 is closed, traffic will be directed to access Wymondham by joining the B1172 at Thickthorn.

All dates are subject to change due to operational requirements.



Keeping the community updated

We've sent a letter discussing the above to every home within a 500m of the scheme, so we can ensure that the local communities who will be impacted by our activity have been informed. We've also provided them with a 24/7 telephone number and email address for the project, so they can get in contact if required.
