

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO13413) affecting the C186 Wymondham Road from its junction with C825 Potash Lane for 870m eastwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Bracon Ash and Hethel to facilitate drainage works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 6<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Wymondham Road, Norwich Road, The Street, Main Road, Mulbarton Road, Ipswich Road, A47, A11, Stanfield Road (Mulbarton, Wrenningham, Cringleford, Hethersett, Wymondham, Bracon Ash, Keswick and Intwood, Swardeston, Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Ketteringham).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

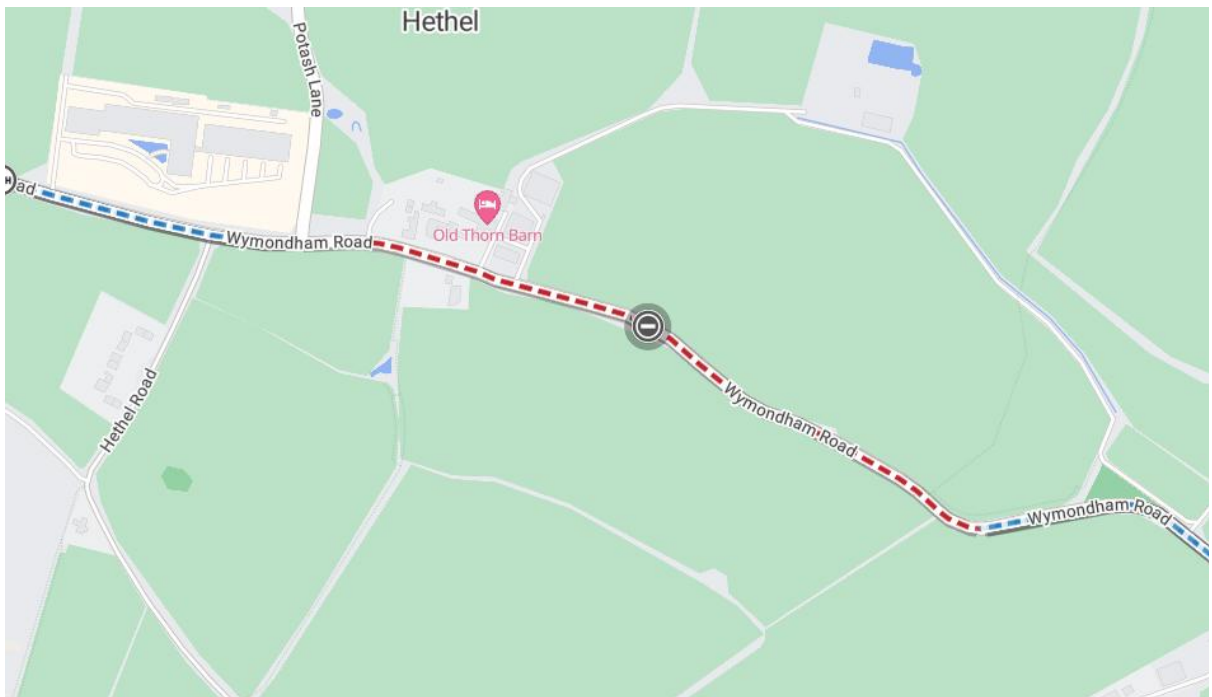
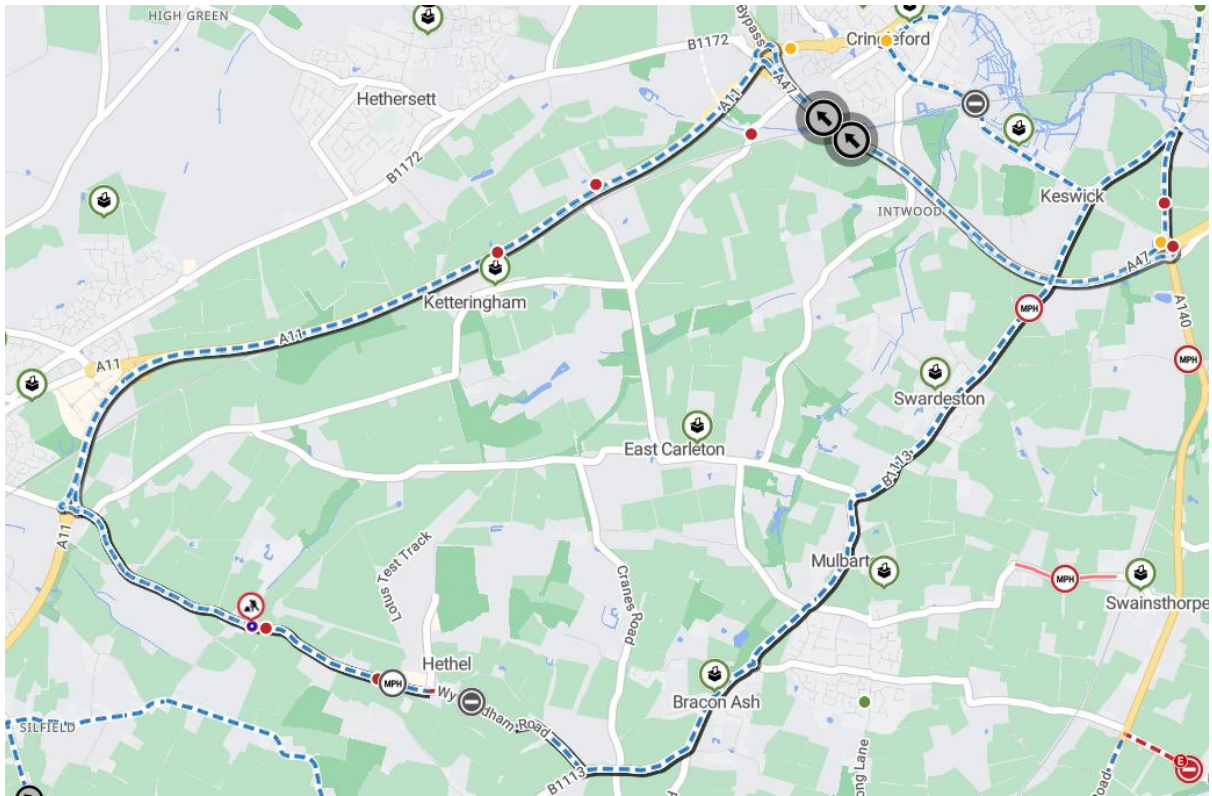
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
